

Telamon.org Website Privacy Statement

Telamon Corporation ("Telamon") places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This Agreement was created in order to demonstrate Telamon's firm commitment to the privacy of our clients, donors and other visitors to this website. The purpose is to let you know how we handle the information you may submit or provide to this website.

What Personal Data Do We Collect?

Telamon only collects personal information from our website that is knowingly provided by our clients, donors or other website visitors. The type of personal information collected could include your name, address, and telephone number. If you are a donor, you may also be asked for your credit card information in order to complete your donation. Your credit card number, if given, is not stored by Telamon and will only be used during the transaction. Telamon will follow any federal or state guidelines regarding the protection of your personal information. You may always "opt out," either now or at any time in the future, if you do not wish to receive our messages by contacting webmaster@telamon.org.

How Your Information May Be Used

The personal information collected is only used to help further the mission of Telamon and we will only use this information for specific, limited purposes. Telamon may create individual profiles with the information provided by users of this site, but for only internal use as to offer assistance to an inquiry or to create a donor record, if applicable. Telamon does not give such personal information to third parties or private organizations. Telamon does not collect information for commercial marketing from its website. Telamon will not send you an unsolicited email regarding any commercial offers or advertisements at any time.

If a user chooses to provide Telamon with personal identifying information, such as sending an email to a Telamon employee, making a donation or by filling out and submitting an online application/submission form located on Telamon's website, Telamon may use that information to respond to the user's message, process the donation, assist in obtaining information the user may have requested or use the information in the manner contemplated by the online submission form. Telamon treats emails and submitted online forms the same way it treats letters to a Telamon department.

Donations on the Website

When a person donates to Telamon, that donation is entered into their record in Telamon's database. We use the information so we can acknowledge your donation and to provide you future communications such as sending you news about events or resources pertinent to your interests. You may always "opt out," either now or at any time in the future, if you do not wish to receive our messages by contacting webmaster@telamon.org.

How Long We Retain Your Personal Data

Telamon only retains your personal data for as long as needed to fulfill the purposes for which it is collected, unless we are required or permitted by law to keep the personal data for longer.

What Data is Processed When You Use Our Website

In general, you may visit our website without providing personal information. Web usage summary statistics are gathered using website analytics software. When you visit the site, our servers make a

temporary record of each access in a log file. By collecting and processing this data, we promote system security and stability, optimize our online services allowing for error and performance analysis, and serve internal statistical needs. Telamon automatically collects and stores the following information about your visit:

- The Internet domain (for example, “xcompany.com” if you use a private Internet access account, or “yourschool.edu” if you connect from a university’s domain) and IP address from which you access Telamon’s website
- The type of browser and operating system used to access Telamon’s website
- The date and time of the visit
- The pages visited
- If you link to Telamon’s website from another website, the address of that website

Cookies or other technology may transfer information from Telamon’s website to your hard disk for record-keeping purposes. Cookies or similar technology can make the Internet more useful by storing information about your preferences on a particular site. The use of cookies or similar technology is an industry standard, and many major websites use them to provide useful features for their users. Cookies in and of themselves do not personally identify users, although they do identify a user’s computer. Most browsers are initially set up to accept cookies. If you’d prefer, you can set yours to refuse cookies. However, you may not be able to take full advantage of Telamon’s website if you do so.

Security

Unless a particular web page on Telamon’s website indicates that encryption technology is being used, the user should NOT assume that information uploaded through that web page to Telamon’s web server will be treated as confidential. If a user submits information to Telamon’s server through a web page containing visible indicators of active encryption technology, Telamon will take all reasonable precautions to safeguard the confidentiality of such information, but shall nevertheless not be held liable for any injury caused by the disclosure of that information, whether caused by security breach, accident, inadvertence, or any other act resulting in disclosure. Your use of the web page on the Telamon’s website constitutes your acknowledgment and consent concerning the potential loss of confidentiality.
